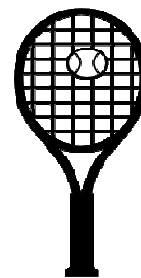
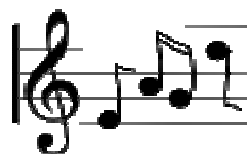


Participants Wanted!



What activities do Victorian children with disabilities take part in?

We need children with disabilities to help us learn about what activities they take part in, outside of school.

What would I need to do?

You will be asked to fill out a questionnaire. This will ask you about the kind of activities you do, how often you do them, who you do them with, and where you do them. We will also ask you about what activities you like to do and whether you enjoy the activities you do. The questionnaire takes between 45 and 65 minutes to fill out. Your parents may help you fill out the questionnaire.

We can send the questionnaire to you by post. Alternatively, if you would prefer, we are happy to meet with you to help you fill out the questionnaire.

Who can take part?

We are inviting over 300 children aged 6 – 18 years with physical disabilities, intellectual disabilities, vision impairment and hearing impairment to take part.

Dr Nora Shields and Ms Annie Synnot from La Trobe University are working together with a number of community, health and education organisations. VicHealth has funded this project.
